Arriving at School

- **No cars allowed in the car park**
Due to increased numbers of pedestrians, this is no longer safe
- One parent/carer only on site
- Arrive at your allocated time to support staggered drop offs:
2a - 8:30 4a - 8:30
2b - 8:30 4b - 8:40
3a - 8:40 5 - 8:30
3b - 8:40
- Do not arrive early for your allocated drop off time to avoid gatherings
- Enter through the right hand gate, following the signage
- Follow the one way system, there will be arrows to direct you
- Observe signage on classroom doors to find your classroom
- Line up using the social distancing spots on the playground
2a and 2b use the social distancing lines in front of the office
- Only children are allowed to enter the classroom/building
- Children will put away belongings and wash their hands on entry
- Please leave the premises promptly



Leaving School

- **No cars allowed in the car park**
Due to increased numbers of pedestrians, this is no longer safe
- One parent/carer only on site
- Arrive at your allocated time to support staggered pick ups
2a - 2:40 4a - 2:40
2b - 2:40 4b - 2:50
3a - 2:50 5 - 2:40
3b - 2:50
- Do not arrive early for your allocated drop off time to avoid gatherings
- Please leave the premises promptly
- When leaving, follow the one way system, there will be arrows to direct you

Additional Information

- Wrap Around Care is only available for Key Worker children and must be pre-booked in advance. It cannot be booked on the day due to staffing
- Messages **will not be able to relayed to class teachers** at the start or end of the school day, appointments will be need to be made in advance if it cannot be done via the phone or email
- Gathering on the school premises **will not be permitted** at any time in line with social distancing



What does my child need / not need?

- They should not wear their tie
- They should wear trainers instead of their school shoes
- They will need sun tan lotion (they **must** be able to apply it themselves)
- They should not bring a book bag
- They should not bring a PE kit
- Children can provide their own lunches or pre-order a school lunch by emailing the school office a day in advance of the week, detailing a request for all the days they are attending
The school lunch consists of a cheese roll, fruit and vegetables and a biscuit or cake
- Charges for lunches will apply for KS2 children as usual
- Children will not be allowed to bring additional objects from home (e.g. teddies)
- Children cannot wear masks or gloves in school in line with Government guidance



The School Office

- Use the school email or phone number where possible
- Make an appointment with the office via the phone or email system if you do need to visit. This is to reduce the number of people gathering near the office
- In an emergency, follow the signage around the office to gain access
- Stand on a social distancing spot whilst waiting
- Wait until the previous person has travelled past the drain before entering (see signage)
- Wash hands or use sanitiser on entry
- Please stand back from the window, using the social distancing floor spot
