- Instead of using an adjective, you can use de + [a noun] to describe something.

winter	de invierno
summer	de verano
sun	de sol
dance	de baile



porque

because

- An adjective must 'agree' with the noun it describes.
- That means it has to be the same gender (masculine or feminine) and number (singular or plural) as the noun.
